What does this cost include? The cost includes a t-shirt, jersey, game expenses & a fee paid directly to Upward Sports for training manuals, practice plans, etc. If you choose to order shorts, that would be an additional \$16. *Partial scholarships are available upon request.*

Who will make the team? Everyone! However, no uniform will be ordered until partial payment has been received. You will be contacted during Christmas break with the night your child's team will hold their practice (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday) and their game time on Saturdays.

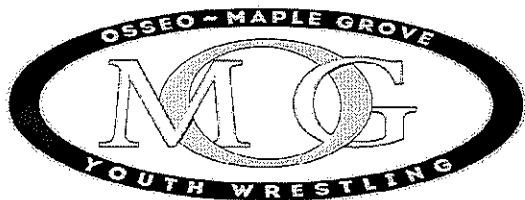

****Fee includes t-shirt, shorts, insurance coverage, and room rental.****

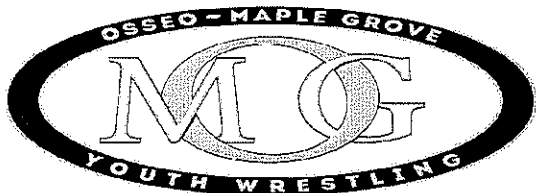

The season starts in the middle of October, with games starting right before Thanksgiving. Season runs through the end of Feb 2018.

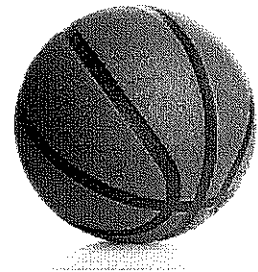
Financial aid is available on a need basis only at the start of the season. To apply, you must attend an in-person registration event on 9/26 or 10/1.

Project Purpose

Young animal lovers who want to help animals in need have a new opportunity to roll up their sleeves and pitch in at Animal Humane Society. Project Purpose, a program for kids ages 12-15, will help provide a deeper understanding of the work AHS does through hands-on service projects.

From filling Kongs for shelter dogs to preparing meals for critters and providing enrichment to cats, kids will gain real-world experience of shelter work. Each three-hour session also features a seasonal project like making pet supply bags for our outreach community.

Project Purpose is currently offered at our Golden Valley location, with plans to expand to Coon Rapids and Woodbury next year.
